CAMDEN VALLEY GOLF RESORT BY-LAWS

POSTING OF COMMITTEES

1. The names of the Members of the General Committee and Sub-Committees shall be kept posted in the Clubhouse.

COMPLAINTS

2. All complaints on any matter connected with the Management or service of the Club or the conduct of any employee of the Club, must be made in writing to the Chief Executive Officer, who shall see that such complaints are referred to the Chairman of the General Committee or the Chairman of the Sub-Committee concerned according to the circumstances.
3. No employee of the Club shall be directly reprimanded by an individual Member.

CHAIRMAN OF DIRECTORS

4. The Chairman of Directors shall be the Executive Director of the Club and shall convey to the Chief Executive Officer the directions of the General Committee (Board of Directors).

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

5. The Chief Executive Officer shall supervise and control all the employees of the Club and shall carry out the directions of the General Committee.

SUSPENSION/CANCELLATION OF MEMBERSHIP

6. The Chief Executive Officer has been empowered by the Board of Directors:-
 - i. To call a Member before a Board meeting called for that purpose to consider whether or not to suspend or cancel the Membership of any Member of any Membership category for misconduct, conduct deemed to be unbecoming of a Member or conduct prejudicial to the interest of the Club.
 - ii. The Member shall be advised in writing of the requirements to attend such a meeting and that their Membership may be suspended or cancelled (effective from the date of the meeting).
 - iii. The resolution passed by the Full Board will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The resolution passed to cancel or suspend a Membership can be reached by a simple majority vote.
 - iv. The Chairman of Directors, the Deputy Chairman of Directors and the Chief Executive Officer (or in his absence his assistant) or any of them shall have the power to exclude any Member from exercising all rights of Membership of the Club if they consider a charge should be laid against that Member under Clause 1 hereof. Such exclusions shall continue until either the

hearing of any such charge is laid against the Member within 7 days of the date of his exclusion, the expiry to such is 7 day.

CARE OF PROPERTY

7. No Member shall remove from the Clubhouse any article belonging to the Club. A Member damaging any property of the Club, otherwise than accidentally shall, in addition to any fine imposed on them, pay for the same, or otherwise make good such damage to the satisfaction of the General Committee. The lending of any property of the Club without the consent of the Chief Executive Officer is expressly forbidden. The Club will not be responsible for any property left at the Club.

CLUB COLOURS

8. Predominantly blue, to be aligned with the Club logo.

DUTIES OF THE COMBINED SUB-COMMITTEE

9. The Combined Sub-Committee in conjunction with the Chief Executive Officer and Course Superintendent shall:-
 - a) Have control and supervision of the upkeep and improvement of the golf course.
 - b) Consider all suggestions for such structural alterations to the course as may involve any change in the conditions of play.
 - c) Arrange the programme of all matches and competitions, select players for all matches or competitions requiring such selection and organise, manage and control the play in all events held on the course.
 - d) Decide and adjudicate upon any protest in connection with match or competition play.
 - e) Make and vary Local Rules.
 - f) Ensure that Members are afforded adequate opportunity for arranging games, and the Members generally are encouraged to make use of the course and Club's social activities. The Combined Sub-Committee reserves the right to alter at its discretion, the programme at any time.
 - g) Alter the handicaps of Members, other than those of Lady Members.

PROTESTS

10. Any protests in connection with a competition shall be delivered in writing to the Chief Executive Officer or to a Member of the Combined Sub-Committee immediately after completion of such competition round or match. Such protests shall be dealt with by the Combined Sub-Committee as early as possible and their decision thereon shall be final.

CARDS AT PLAY

11. A card issued by a Member of the Combined Sub-Committee or by their deputy, must be obtained from such person as they may direct before playing in any competition and the entrance fee thereon paid. No other

card shall be recognised. All cards returned must be dated, signed by the player and marker and returned immediately after completion of the round.

REFRESHMENTS

12. Members shall pay the bar attendant immediately upon being served or supplied, all expenses incurred for refreshments or other articles supplied by or through them. All refreshments and other articles sold or supplied by or through the steward/stewardess shall be paid in such a manner as the Committee shall direct from time to time. No glass containing refreshments shall be taken onto the course, property or surrounds. Failure to comply with the By-Law may result in suspension of playing rights.

DISPLAY OF NOTICES, ETC.

13. Except as to records and notices required by the Rules or By-Laws of the Club to be posted or displayed by other Committees, no notice, publication, picture or documents shall be posted, suspended or otherwise displayed with the Clubhouse or its precincts without the sanction of the Chief Executive Officer.

VISITORS ENTRY INTO CLUB COMPETITIONS

14. The Golf Committee have been empowered by the Board of Directors to reserve the right to exclude any visiting competitor entering into a Club competition and/or event. The decision of the Golf Committee is final and no discussion shall be entered into as a result of the decision of the Committee on this issue.

COLLECTIONS

15. Collections for charitable or other purposes shall not be made on the Club's property, nor shall the sale of tickets in lotteries or raffles or any function be made on the Club's property without the sanction of the Chief Executive Officer.

OBLIGATION OF MEMBERS

16. The player on the lowest handicap in any match shall act as Captain of the match for the purpose of ensuring that the etiquette of golf is observed by all Members of the match, particularly in regard to the 'call through' rule. Should two (2) or more players be equally handicapped they should decide amongst themselves who shall act as the Match Captain.

GAMBLING

17. Gambling of any type shall not be permitted on Club premises.

DRESS RULES

18. Dress rules are shown on various notices. The standard of dress requirements on the course is largely left to the good taste of the Golf Operations Manager, Course Ranger, Directors and Management. However, for guidance:-

CHILDREN

19. Persons under the age of 18 years are not allowed on licensed premises unless specified as a non-restricted area. Persons under the age of 18 years are not permitted to play Poker Machines, purchase alcohol or tobacco products.

FINANCIAL STATUS

20. No Member will be eligible to participate in any Club Competition after 30th June, 2010 if not financial or has not paid such Subscription instalment as may be determined by the General Committee from time to time.

SLOW PLAY

The regularly recurring problem of 'SLOW PLAY' is discussed consistently amongst Members. Almost every player/Member of the Club has at some time expressed concern about the effects of slow play on their enjoyment of the game. The following ten suggestions should be of assistance in overcoming this problem.

BY FAR THE MOST IMPORTANT RULE IS BRIEF:

- (a) Each player walks directly to or adjacent to their ball at all times and waits there for the player furthest from the hole to play their shot.
- (b) That they use this time to assess their own shot.

WE REQUEST THAT ALL PLAYERS GET INTO THE HABIT OF PLAYING IN THIS MANNER.

HERE ARE SOME FACTORS WHICH CONTRIBUTE TO SLOW PLAY.

1. Not being ready to hit from the tee.
2. Delays on tees or greens whilst marking the card.
3. Players waiting with the player shortest of the tee until they have hit their shot, then walking to their own balls.
4. Unnecessary number of practice swings.
5. Delays in locating lost balls.
6. Lack of discretion in going through a group that has lost a ball.
7. On the green, unnecessary marking of balls and players not continuing to putt out.
8. Players not using the time on the green, whilst waiting their turn to assess their own putt.
9. Incorrect handling of the flag on the green.
10. Leaving buggies around the green on the wrong side to the tee.

HERE ARE SOME POINTS THAT MAY HELP US TO CURB SLOW PLAY

1. Select club and ball whilst other players are having their shots.
2. Always mark the card whilst awaiting your turn at the tee.
3. Walk directly to your own ball, or level with same, and select club to be used whilst waiting for the others to have their shots.
4. It is agreed that each player has his own preference in this matter, but practice swings should be limited by discretion.
5. If after a reasonable period, it is apparent that you are holding up play,

- call the next group through.
6. If called ahead as in #(5) but immediately afterwards the ahead locate their ball and evidently play will proceed faster if they continue, you should signal them to go ahead. NOTE: The discretion is in the hands of the team called through and not the players that were lost.
 7. On reaching the green and your ball, study the line of your putt immediately. When it is your turn to putt, try, and whenever possible, putt right out. Marking the ball is sometimes necessary, but not always, and should be avoided.
 8. Wherever possible, a player should have assessed his own putt for direction and speed whilst other players are putting, providing, in doing so, no interference is caused by the player.
 9. The player nearest the hole should attend the flag and then pass to the first player to hole out, then appraise their own putt.
 10. Always place your buggy adjacent to the approach to the next tee.

TIME SHEETS

Time sheets for future Saturday events will be made available at the office on **FRIDAYS** between the hours 3.30 p.m. and 4.00 p.m. for Members present in the Clubhouse and between **4.00 pm and 4.30 pm** for phone bookings. **PHONE BOOKINGS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED ON (02) 9606 7530.** All Booking Sheets will be available 2 weeks in advance.

All booking sheets will be available for bookings and cancellations between the hours of 9.30 am and 5.00 pm only, 7 days a week through the administration office.

Players are also requested to report to the starter (15) minutes prior to hit-off time and on collection of their score cards be ready and report to their allocated hit-off tee. Failure to be on time could mean relegation to the end of the field or even suspension to play.

COMPETITION STRUCTURE AND TEE ALLOCATIONS

One Tee Start - will be conducted in all competitions held during the months of January, February, March, April, September, October, November and December.

Two Tee Start - will be conducted in all competitions held during the months of May, June, July and August.

Competitions and course allocations may be altered at the Combined Sub-Committees' discretion.

COMPETITION FEE

All fees shall be determined at the discretion of the Committee from time to time.

VISITORS AND INVITATION

All Saturday events are for Camden Valley Golf Resort 7 day playing Members only, unless specified as an Invitation event. Open days appear in the programme and visitors are welcome to play. Invitation means one visitor per Member.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

- (a) Financial Members with a full handicap under non restricted classes of Membership.
- (b) All matches shall be played from the fixed distance markers and have right of way at all times.
- (c) All Championship matches must be played on the date and time set down by the Combined Sub-Committee.

TROPHY ALLOCATION

Trophy allocation shall at times be at the discretion of the Committee, but the following general guidelines apply. When players can compete for more than one trophy, a player will be restricted to taking one trophy only. In this respect the order of precedence shall be as follows.

NET EVENTS

- 1. Major handicap trophy
- 2. Minor handicap trophy
- 3. Best scratch trophy

SCRATCH EVENTS

- 1. Major scratch trophy
- 2. Runner-up scratch
- 3. Net winner trophy

Scratch scores must be recorded on the scorecard to be eligible for the scratch trophy.

Best scratch score trophy will be awarded for Monthly Medal events regardless of score returned.

In all events the ball competition shall be determined on the net scores returned.

CLUB COMPETITIONS

The minimum fields for allocation of trophies shall be as follows:

Single events	Fifteen (15) Players
Members 2 Ball	Fifteen (15) Pairs
Invitation 2 Ball	Fifteen (15) Pairs
Mixed 2 Ball	Fifteen (15) Pairs

If less than the numbers specified participate then the competition will be converted to a ball competition.

HANDICAPS

A grade - scratch to 12

B grade - 13 to 19

C grade - 20 to 32

Open events maximum handicap limit of 27 Australian and any associated events, a maximum Domestic handicap of 32 applies. Open Mixed events a maximum of 36 to apply for visiting Lady Members unless otherwise specified for the event.

HANDICAP CARDS

All Members must check their handicap on the score card, before playing a competition, as an incorrectly marked card may lead to disqualification from the net event.

Rules must be read and understood, as a breach of rules MAY mean disqualification

New Members playing for a handicap, must lodge five (5) cards that must be marked by an affiliated Member. New Members transferring from another Club must bring written proof of their exact handicap.

COMPETITION HANDICAPS

1. SINGLE STROKE - Full handicap.

STABLEFORD - Full handicap.

PAR - Full handicap.

2. FOURSOMES HANDICAP - To calculate the handicap for foursomes competition over 18 holes, add partners stroke handicaps together and take 1/2 of the aggregate. 18 holes - 1/2 handicap.

Eg. 15 + 18 = 33. 1/2 of 33 is 16 1/2.

3. CANADIAN FOURSOMES HANDICAPS - To calculate the handicap for Canadian foursomes stroke, par or stableford competitions add the partners stroke handicaps together and take 3/8 the aggregate as per AGU Handbook recommendations.

4. AMBROSE - To calculate for four person Ambrose, add four handicaps together and take 1/8 of total. For two person Ambrose, add two handicaps together and take 1/4 of total.

5. AMERICAN FOURSOMES - To calculate the handicap for American Foursomes, add partners stroke handicaps together and take 3/8 of the total.

CANCELLATIONS

If you find it necessary to cancel or if you are unable to hit-off at the time reserved, you are expected to inform the office accordingly (**by 4.00 pm THE DAY BEFORE the scheduled event**), in order that another player may be given the opportunity to play, and your partner or opponents are informed of the change. If a Member or visitor is found to be in breach of this By-Law on three or more occasions (within a twelve Month period), the Member or visitor's playing rights with this Club will be suspended for a period of two (2) Months.

HANDICAP REVIEW

The Golf Sub-Committee may from time to time approve the alteration of a Member's handicap if, in its absolute discretion and having regard to all circumstances including the Member's results in any form of competition, it considers that the change is warranted under the handicap system which the Club follows. The Member shall have no right to make any representations to the handicapper or to the Golf Sub-Committee in relation to any proposed alteration of the Member's handicap.

It is the handicapper's aim to arrange handicaps in order that all competitors may have a reasonable chance of success. Members are requested to assist in this respect by returning all competition cards whether the round is completed or not. Handicaps of players will be reviewed on the day of the event in accordance with the guidelines set down by the Australian Golf Union.

RESPONSIBILITY

Each competitor holds a position of trust in respect of the whole field of players. It is his duty not only to play the game, but to see that his partner and his fellow competitors play the game strictly in accordance with the rules of golf (and local rules), that scores are correctly marked and that the etiquette of golf is observed.

CORRECT MARKING AND RETURN OF SCORE CARDS

Your attention is drawn to the Rules of Golf governing the correct keeping of score.

Eg. (a) Rule 6- Section 6, (b) Rule 31- Sections 4 and 7, (c) Rule 32- Section 1(b).

Members are required to complete score cards and hand them in immediately on completion of the round. Members please note, incomplete cards are required to be handed in.

THE MARKERS

In the absence of Blue Markers on the teeing area, players shall hit-off from permanent markers.

All competitions, unless otherwise specified, shall be played off the Blue Markers.

NOTICE BOARD

Members should make a habit of checking the notices on the board before play each day to make sure of any deletions or additions to temporary local rules, etc.

MIXED COMPETITION PLAY

The following conditions will apply:

- (a) In 2 Ball events, Lady Members shall play off a full handicap in stableford and par events.
- (b) In foursome events, Lady Members shall play from their own tee.

TIES IN COMPETITION PLAY

A play-off for a tie in a major event shall be determined by the Committee according to the circumstances and conditions involved. A tie in a Monthly Medal will be played off in the following Medal round and where two competitions are being held on that day, all players involved in the tie must play in the same competition. In all other events a count back shall be used to decide the winner.

A tie for the Club Championship (Scratch) and Foursomes Championship will require a play-off over four (4) holes on the day. Holes 1, 2, 26 and 27 will be used. If the scores are still tied after the four hole play-off, then sudden death over the same holes will apply.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All Members are registered with the NSW Golf Association. On receiving an Australian handicap you are then qualified to enter OPEN EVENTS on other courses. NSW Golf Association fixtures and regular inter-Club visits require that all golfers study the 'Rules of Golf' and 'Golf Etiquette' to avoid any possible misunderstandings and disqualifications.

NON-PLAYING MEMBERS

A non-playing Member is entitled to all social privileges of the Club to entertain guests but is only entitled to use the course paying normal social green fees at times when available, and other than that allocated for Club competitions.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

- Replace your divots or instruct your caddy to do so.
- Competition players have precedence over other players at all times.
- Subject to conditions governing competition play, two balls have precedence over three and four ball groups.
- If players fail to keep their place on the course, the normal courtesy of 'calling through' must be observed. If they fail to do so the players following MUST indicate that they intend to exercise their right to go through.
- Players searching for a ball should allow other players coming up to pass them. They should signal to the players following them to pass and should not continue their game until those players have passed and are out of range.

- No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
- When leaving bunkers, think of other unfortunates. Smooth out your foot marks.
- No player should play until the party ahead is out of range.
- In the interest of all, players should play with out delay. Penalty for breach of rule - 2 strokes - Rule 6/7.
- When the result of the hole has been determined players should immediately leave the putting green.
- Do not take buggies or drop clubs on the green.
- Avoid as far as possible walking or standing near the hole.
- Players MUST NOT play practice shots from mown fairways or to any green not allocated for that purpose.
- The flag stick should be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green.
- All players should carry and use a soil bucket to repair divots.
- Through the green, a player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by him is replaced at once, pressed down, and top-dressed with soil.
- On the greens, after the players have holed out, any damage to the putting green made by the ball should be carefully repaired. Please repair your pitch mark and where possible one other.
- Players wishing to practise on the golf course itself should report to the Professional shop before commencing, and during their practice round are restricted to the use of a maximum of 'TWO' golf balls in play at any one time.
- IN PAR AND STABLEFORD COMPETITIONS, PLAYERS WHO HAVE EXHAUSTED THEIR STROKES AT ANY HOLE SHOULD PICK UP.

The standard of a Golf Club may be judged by the etiquette of it's Members.

It is the duty of every Member to preserve the reputation of the Club by:-

- a) Maintaining the spirit of good fellowship between himself and every other Member.
- b) Extending the hand of welcome to all visitors.
- c) Observing the best traditions of the game when visiting other Clubs.
- d) Observing the rules of proper golf attire.
- e) Refer to score cards and notice boards in the Club for all local rules.
- f) Any competitor desiring to enter a protest in connection with a match or competition shall do so in writing, addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, and shall deposit same in the box with the cards of play. The Chief Executive Officer, upon receipt of such protests, shall convene at the earliest possible opportunity, a meeting of the Combined Sub-Committee who shall consider such protests and whose decision shall be final. Protests must be entered immediately on the completion of the match or competition.

- g) Friends invited into the Clubhouse must be properly signed into the Visitors Book and their behaviour, whilst in the Club, will be the responsibility of the inviting Member.

GENERAL BEHAVIOUR

Members should avoid unnecessary shouting on the course or in the Clubhouse. Bad language will not be tolerated.

Members are requested to acquaint themselves with the 'Golf Rules'. Copies may be obtained from the Club Office, when available.

Regular attention should be given to local rules posted on the notice board adjacent to the Pro shop. These local rules will take precedence over rules shown on the score cards where they are at variance.

Members should not interfere with non-Members playing on the course, although tactful advice may be given if a breach of the 'Rules of Golf or 'Golf Etiquette' is noticed.

COMMON EVENTS

2B Stableford – The best net stableford score out of the pair will count as the teams score for each hole. For the Scratch event, the best scratch stableford score will count as the team score.

2B Aggregate – The combined net stableford score of both players in the pair. For the scratch event the combined scratch score for both players will count as the team score.

Stroke – Stableford points do not apply in stroke events, and each player is to complete the hole regardless of how many shots they have had, until the ball is in the hole.

Sixes Teams Event – This is a teams aggregate event where for holes 1-6, the best net stableford score in the whole group will count as the team score. For holes 7, 8, 9, 19, 20,21 the best two net stableford scores in the group will count as the team score, and for holes 22-27, the best three net stableford scores will count as the team score. For the scratch event, the best scratch scores will count, in the same manner as the net event.

Ambrose – The best shot out of the group is selected and then each player is to hit their ball from that spot. This is repeated for every shot until the ball is in the hole. Each player must use their tee shot on at least two (2) occasions throughout the round. Scorecard must be initialled.
